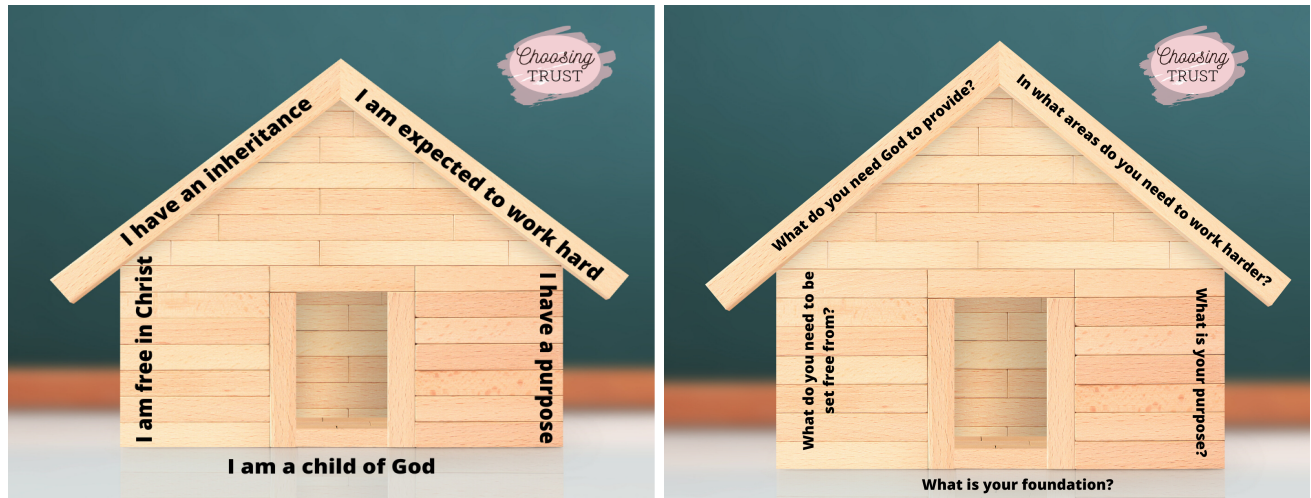


IDENTITY 101
